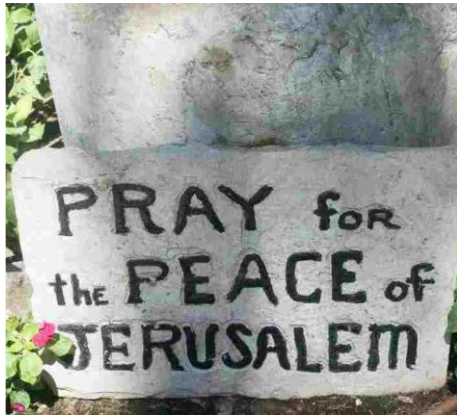
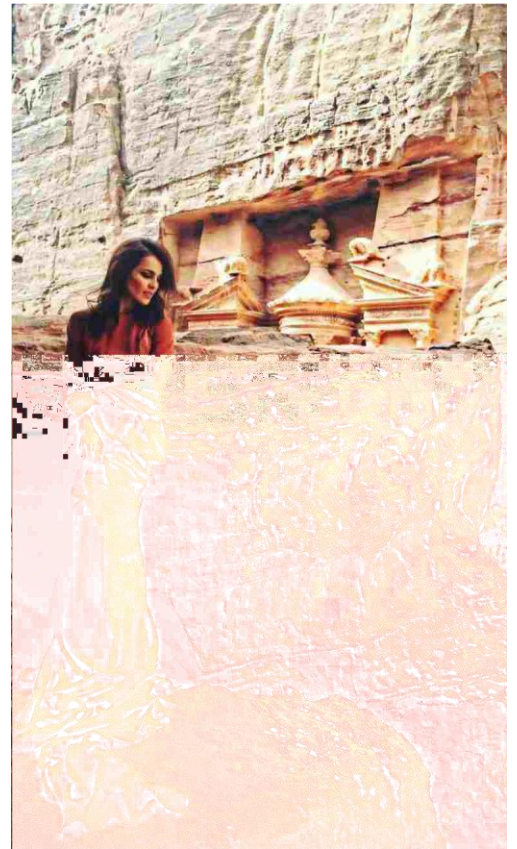
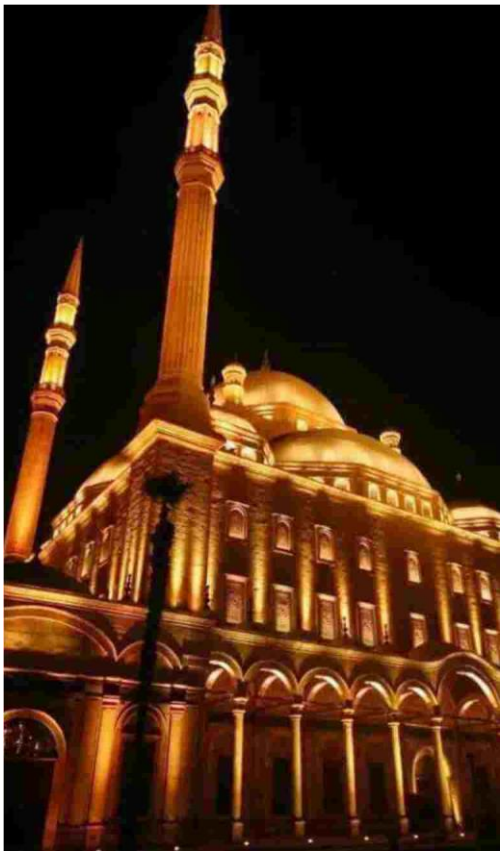

JORDAN - ISRAEL - JORDAN (5 Nights)

DAY 1: ARRIVAL AMMAN AIRPORT

Meet and assist at Amman airport - start your visit with Mt Nebo - Madaba - cross into Israel and stop at Jericho. This was the first city conquered when the Israelites entered the Promise Land. Also visit Yardenit for renewal of baptism. Then we will proceed to Tiberias for Dinner and Overnight.

DAY 2: SEA OF GALILEE - CAPERNAUM - TABGHA - MT. OF BEATITUDES

Morning cruise on the Sea of Galilee - along its shores much of Jesus' public ministry took place; where Jesus walked on the water (Mark 6:48). A good opportunity to reflect on the messages of our Lord as we savour the beauty of nature while sailing at the Sea of Galilee. Proceed to Capernaum, where Jesus lived after he left Nazareth; here, Jesus preached to the people and manifested His goodness and omnipotence by many miracles. Capernaum was the home of St. Peter. Proceed to the Greek Orthodox Church and the nearby archaeological excavations of the Synagogue and community. Drive to nearby Tabgha, the site where Jesus performed the Miracle of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fish; visit the Church of the Loaves and Fish. On the stone which serves as the altar, there is mosaic of basket of loaves flanked by two fish to commemorate this miraculous event. Two hundred yards away is the Church of Primacy, built in 1934 in basalt over a massive rock called "Mensa Christi". Here where the Risen Lord appeared to his disciples, prepared breakfast for them and gave St. Peter the pastoral commission, Feed my Sheep (John 21:15-19). Ascend to the Mount of the Beatitudes. This is the traditional site where Jesus uttered the immortal words "Blessed are the poor in Spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of God". (Matthew 5:3-12). Visit the Church and its grounds for private reading of the Sermon on the Mount.

DAY 3: GALILEE - MT TABOR - CANA - NAZRETH – HAIFA

After breakfast, drive across to the Gallilee - on the way to visit Haifa - then view Caesarea. The aqueducts of the crusader city -drive via the port city of Haifa, Mount Carmel - visit the Stella Marris Church and the Bahai Shrine and Gardens. Continue to visit Nazareth, the place where Jesus spent His childhood; the Church of the Annunciation. May it be done to me according to your word" and Mary's well. Drive to Cana for a visit of the Church of the First Miracle known also as the Marriage Church

DAY 4: JERUSALEM - OLD CITY - BETHLEHEM

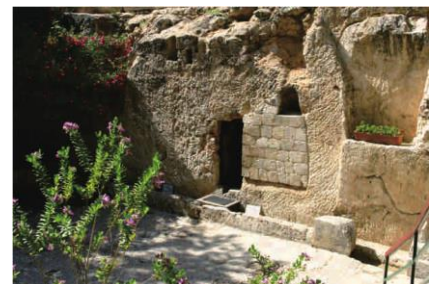
After breakfast, visit Via Dolorosa - an opportunity to carry a cross while performing meditations on the 14 Stations of the Cross then visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre – the burial place and resurrection of Jesus. It was built over the site of the place called Golgotha, which means "a place of skull". Precede your tour of the Old City, starting from the St. Stephen's Gate (the Lion's Gate), stopping at St. Anne's Church – regarded as the birthplace of the Virgin Mary and the home of St. Anne and Joachim, the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus told the lame man to take up his bed and walk. Visit the Cardo and the Jewish Quarter before arriving at the Western (Wailing) Wall, the last vestige of the second temple, where Jews all over the world gather to commemorate the destruction of the first and second temple and pray for Israel's restoration. Drive to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus and visit the Church of the Nativity, where we find the Grotto of Nativity and Altar of Christ's Birth and Manger's Square. Time for some last-minute gift shopping at one of the Church stores around before returning to Hotel for dinner and overnight

DAY 5: JERUSALEM - QUMRAN - DEAD SEA

The morning visits the Mount of Olives for a group photo with a scenic backdrop of Jerusalem and the Church of Our Father (Matt. 6: 5-15) contained the Lord's Prayer over 85 languages. Towards Dominus Flevit (Lk. 21: 20-24) where Jesus wept over Jerusalem City, Palm Sunday (Mar. 11: 1-11) and the Garden of Gethsemane (Lk. 22: 39-42) where the Lord Jesus spent his last moments before being arrested Roman soldiers. Proceed to the discovery of the Qumran scrolls of scripture. In the afternoon you are given the opportunity return to float in the Dead Sea on the Israeli side, while you relax and unwind. Then back to the hotel in Jerusalem to rest.

DAY 6: JERUSALEM-ALLENBY-AMMAN- AIRPORT

After breakfast we left Jerusalem to Allenby Border-Lunch and towards Queen Alia International Airport in Amman to return to your country



JORDAN - ISRAEL - JORDAN (6 Nights)

DAY 1: ARRIVAL AMMAN AIRPORT

On the stone which serves as the altar, there is mosaic of basket of loaves flanked by two fish to commemorate this miraculous event. Two hundred yards away is the Church of Primacy, built in 1934 in basalt over a massive rock called "Mensa Christi". Here where the Risen Lord appeared to his disciples, prepared breakfast for them and gave St. Peter the pastoral commission, Feed my Sheep (John 21:15-19). Ascend to the Mount of the Beatitudes. This is the traditional site where Jesus uttered the immortal words "Blessed are the poor in Spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of God". (Matthew 5:3-12). Visit the Church and its grounds for private reading of the Sermon on the Mount.

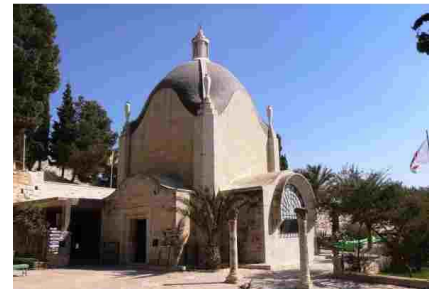
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DAY 4: JERUSALEM - BETHLEHEM - JERUSALEM

Proceed to Jerusalem to the Mount Zion to visit the Tomb of King David, the Last Supper Room the Church of Dormition Abbey and the Church Rooster crowed, then to the Church of St. Anna and the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the lame man on the Sabbath (followed by Worship the Way of the Cross on the Via Dolorosa, starting from the Church of Jesus Flagellation visit Sepulchre r the holy Sepulchre at Golgotha Hill **DAY 5: JERUSALEM** Toward the Mount of Olives where Jesus visited Bukit Increment taken to Heaven (Luk.24: 50-53), the Church of Our Father where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer (Luk.11: 1-4), and then pass through Jalan Palm (Jn .12: 12-15), to the Church of God Crying where Jesus wept over Jerusalem and the predicted collapse (Luk.19: 41-44), and to the Church of all Nations in Gethsemane where Jesus prayed on the night before his death. Then towards the Church of the Nativity of John the Baptist (Luk.1: 57-66). Before returning to the hotel, you will visit the Wailing Wall, where Jews pray and mourn the destruction of the Temple.

DAY 6: JERUSALEM - JERICHO- QUMRAN- DEAD SEA Today we visit Qumran where the discovery of ancient scrolls of Scripture. Then Jericho the, the oldest town in the world to see Mt of Temptation experiment where Jesus tempted by Satan (Mat.4: 1-17), the Tree Zacchaeus (Luk.19: 1-10) and Springs Elisa (2Raja.2: 19-22) after lunch then you will feel the joy float in the Dead Sea.

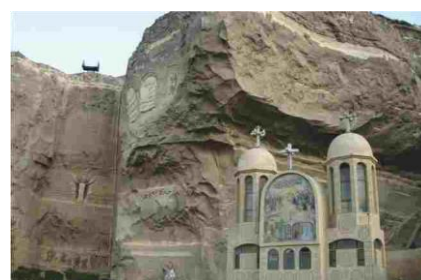
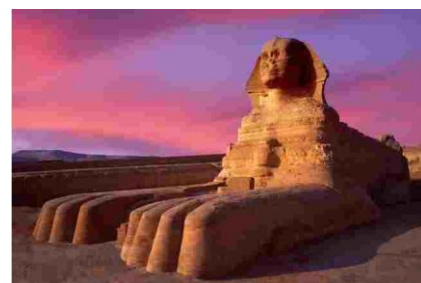
DAY 6: JERUSALEM - TEL AVIV - NAZARETH - CANA - TIBERIAS

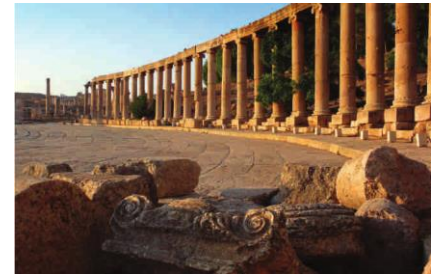
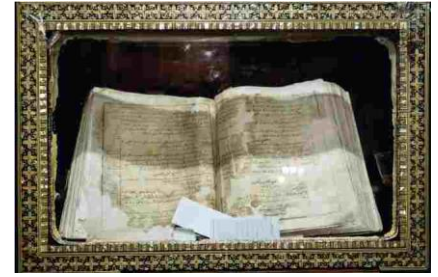
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DAY 8: SHEIKH HUSSEIN - JERASH - ANJARA - ALJUN - AMMAN

Pilgrimage to the Church of Our Lady of the Mountain, the cave which was rebuilt and venerated as the place where Jesus and his mother, Mary died while on their way between Galilee, Decapolis cities, Bethany beyond the Jordan and Jerusalem. Anjara appointed by the Vatican as a place of pilgrimage of the millennium in 2000. Then visit the castle in Aljun. Back to Amman for overnight.

DAY 4: JERUSALEM - JERICHO - QUMRAN - DEAD SEA

Today we visit Qumran where the discovery of ancient scrolls of Scripture. Then Jericho the, The oldest town in the world to see Mt of Temptation experiment where Jesus tempted by Satan (Mat.4: 1-17), the Tree Zacchaeus (Luk.19: 1-10) and Springs Elisa (2Raja.2: 19-22) after lunch Then you will feel the joy float in the Dead Sea.

Beatitude (Mat.5: 1-12), Tabgha is the place where Jesus performed miracles doubling the 5 loaves and two fish to feed 5,000 people (Yoh.6: 1-5), Capernaum (Town of Jesus, Luk.4: 31- 41), lunch with fish menu Peter, sailed in the Sea of Galilee by boat the time of Jesus (Mat.8: 2-27). Namely the late afternoon to Yardenit baptismal site on the Jordan River (Mat.3: 3-17). Then we will pass the Sheikh Hussein border to go to Amman.

DAY 8: AMMAN - PETRA - DEAD SEA

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DAY 9, DEAD SEA - AMMAN- AMMAN AIRPORT

After breakfast we will past Mt. Nebo Lunch Amman than to Queen Alia International Airport in Amman to return in your country.

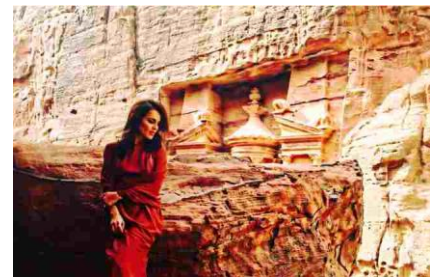
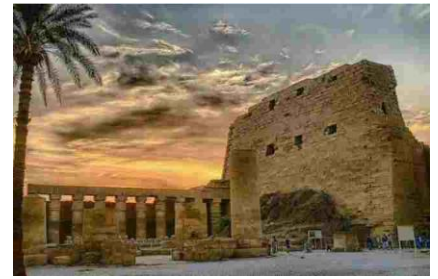
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DAY 9: AMMAN -PETRA - DEAD SEA
